SEN is talked about in 4 broad areas in the SEN Code of Practice (2014):

C&L - Cognition and Learning

C&I - Communication and Interaction

SEMH - social, emotional and mental health difficulties.

Sensory and / or physical needs

ADD: Attention Deficit Disorder

ADHD: Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder

ASD: Autism Spectrum Disorder

CAMHS: Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services (also referred to as NELFT)

EHCP: Education, Health & Care Plan (these have replaced Statements)

EP: Educational Psychologist

EWO: Education Welfare Officer (now known as School Liaison Officers/SLO)

FLO: Family Liaison Officer

HI: Hearing Impairment

LA: Local Authority

MLD: Moderate Learning Difficulty

MSI: Multi-Sensory Impairment

OT: Occupational Therapy/Therapist

PD: Physical Disability

PMLD: Profound and Multiple Learning Difficulties

PP: Pupil Premium

PR: Parental Responsibility

SALT/SLT: Speech & Language Therapy/Therapist

SEN: Special Educational Needs

SENCo: Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator

SEND Special Educational Needs and Disabilities

SLCN: Speech, Language & Communication Needs

SLD: Severe Learning Difficulties

SLO: School Liaison Officer

SpLD: Specific Learning Difficulties
