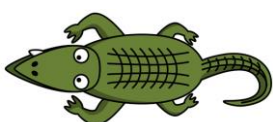
We will be sending home a new learning log this week with the first homework due on **THURSDAY 15th January**. Maths Homework will begin on Monday **12th January**

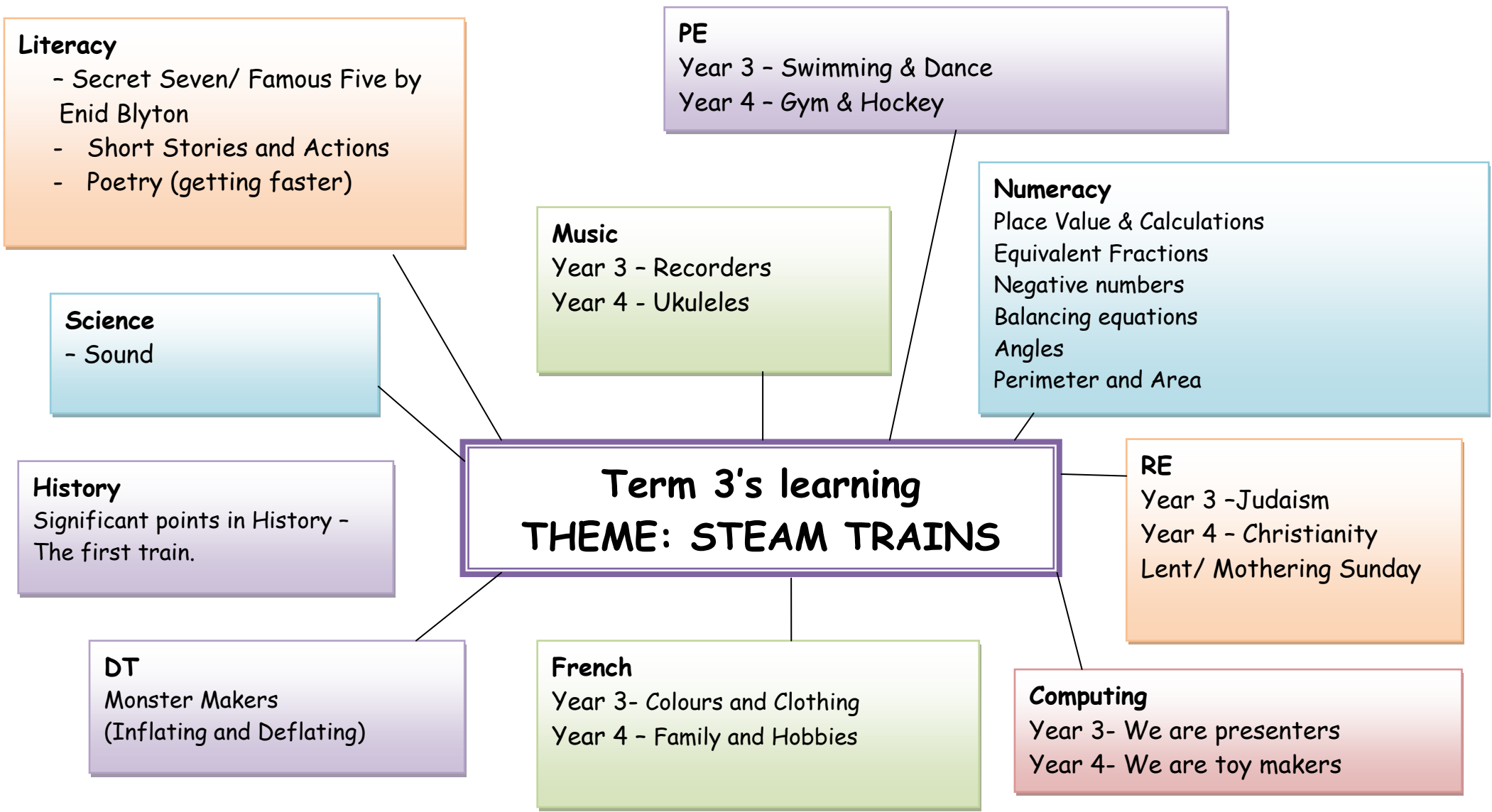
Recorders in Year 3 - As the play last term took up a large quantity of music time, recorders will begin this term.
