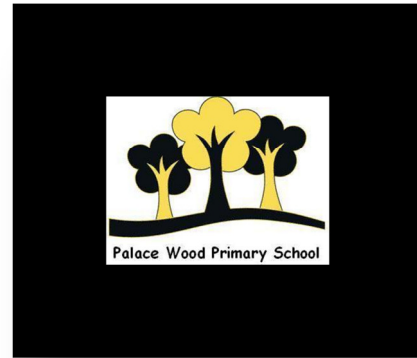


Year 3 and 4 Phase Newsletter March 2015
