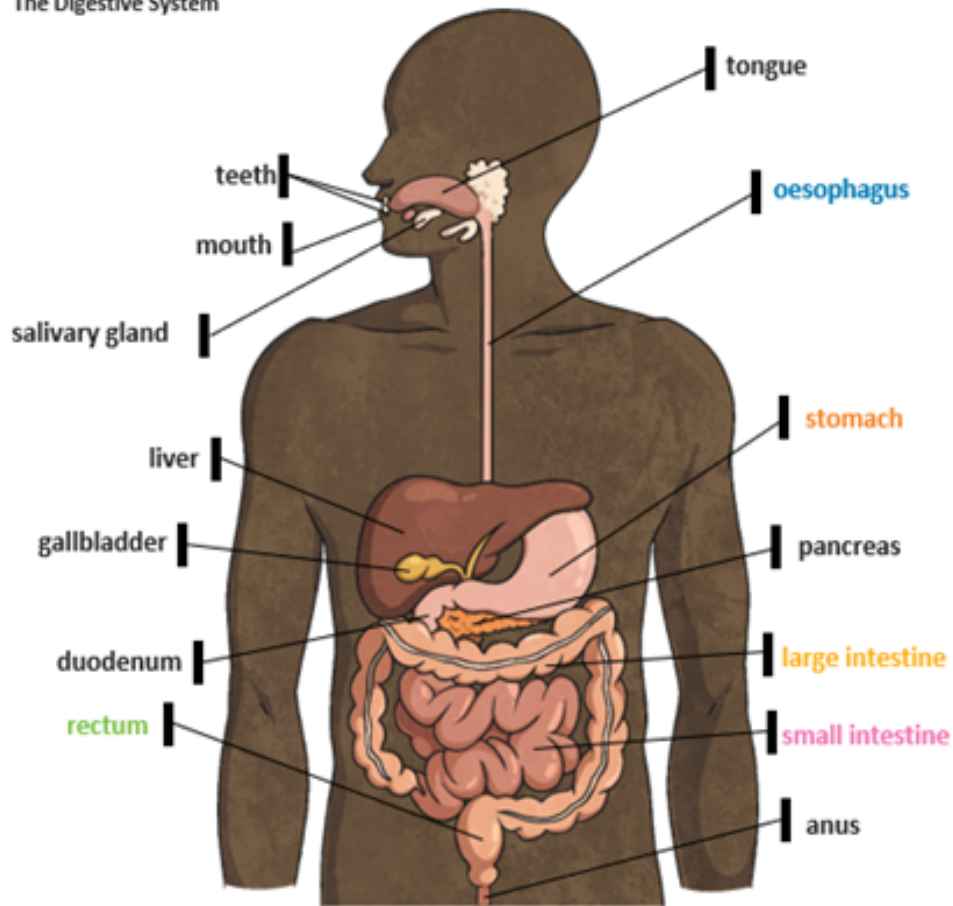
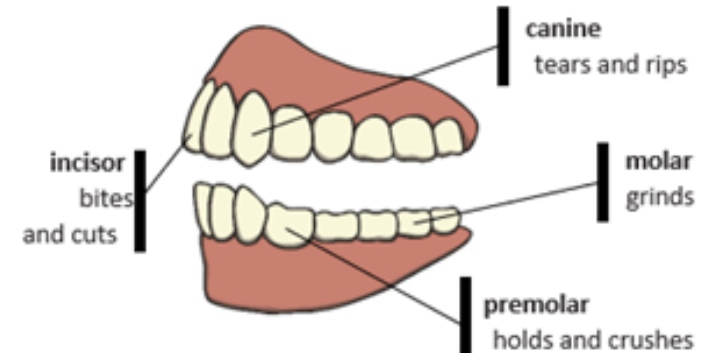


The Digestive System



Vocabulary	
digestive system	Where food is broken down so it can be used by the body
oesophagus	A muscular tube which moves food from the mouth to the stomach
stomach	An organ where food is broken down with stomach acid
Small intestine	Part of the intestine where nutrients are absorbed into the body
Large intestine	Part of the intestine where water is absorbed from remaining waste food
rectum	Part of the digestive system where faeces are stored before leaving the body
food chain	It shows the food that animals and plants need
producer	A plant that produces its own food
predator	An animal that hunts and eats other animals
prey	An animal that gets hunted and eaten by another animal
